

C3 Logix (iPad delivered Concussion Assessments)

Graded Symptoms

- AT will administer Graded Symptoms Follow-Up Assessment(s)
- Must score within 2 points of Baseline Assessment to be considered Asymptomatic
- Must remain Asymptomatic for 48 consecutive without the use of medications hours to move on to remaining assessments
- AT will make determination of Graded Symptoms Clearance
- Parents contacted when Student-Athlete Clears Graded Symptoms
 - If no resolutions of Symptoms within 2-3 weeks, Parents will be contacted regarding referral to PCP, STARS, or St Luke's Concussion Clinic

All remaining assessments of C3 Logix will be delivered in a single follow-up assessment session. Results will then be sent to that quadrant directing physician for interpretation & clearance determination. Parents will be notified of assessment results.

SAC

- AT will administer SAC (*Standard Assessment of Concussion*) Assessment

BESS

- AT will administer BESS (*Balance Error Scoring System*) Assessment

Visual – Ocular

- AT will administer Visual/Ocular Assessment

Neurocognitive

- AT will administer 4 Neurocognitive Assessments

CV Test

- AT will administer a Cardiovascular Assessment following C3 Logix Assessments
 - 5-10 minutes of vigorous exercises (*calisthenics, agility drills, jumping, running*)
 - This is followed by 15 minutes of mild aerobic activity (*Bike or Jog*)
- Check for Return of Symptoms
 - If NO Return of Symptoms, Student-Athlete is entered into 5-Step RTP
 - This assessment will count as Step 1 of 5-Step RTP
 - If Symptoms Return, Student-Athlete returns to state of Rest until Symptoms Resolve using Graded Symptoms

Return To Learn

- **Return-to-Learn clearance MUST be received BEFORE they can begin Graduated Return-to-Play steps.**
- Student-Athlete believes that are able to perform in the classroom without accommodations.
- Clearance from Teachers will be required.
 - Teachers feel student-athlete can handle academic requirements of the classroom.
 - Teachers & student-athlete have a plan in place for completing late work.
- Clearance from Parents will be required.
 - Parents believe their child has no academics issues related to the head injury and will be able to continue with coursework without accommodations.
